- PAGE is a Purchasing COOPERATIVE for privately owned newspapers and newspaper groups
- Members must be a daily or non-daily general interest newspaper or be part of a group with a daily or non-daily general interest newspaper

Stated Values of PAGE Cooperative

- Each member-owner shares equally in the ownership and control of the PAGE Cooperative.
- All members regardless of size are treated equally and receive the same pricing from the same supplier.

- Since 2006 PAGE has partnered with Cox Newsprint Supply to Purchase Newsprint.
- From that point thru April of 2018 PAGE used a blended price with differences only for Eastern and Western regional pricing.
- Current marketplace has changed that concept with significant differences per suppliers affected by CVD's and ADD's
