



In late 1990s Harland Simon was fighting in a very competitive market for controls upgrades

- Existing control suppliers winning projects especially with KBA and MAN
- Press manufacturers starting to produce on-unit controls

Decided on the following two strategies...

- Flexibility of front end desks and management systems
 - Modular PC based system called PRESSNET allowed communication to multiple press vendors and auxiliary systems
- Standard hardware for PLC and drives
 - Shift focus from hardware developer to solutions provider

Prima Controls Group – Specialists in Retrofits



Initially:

- Used Siemens as Rockwell was seen as competitor
- Used B&R on some projects to work with Goss

As US market developed started focusing on Allen Bradley as de-facto standard in US












